WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to establish a reserve fund and will entitle it the Vacation and Sick Day Allotment Capital Reserve Fund from DB Fund Town Highway Outside of Village (hereinafter Reserve Fund), pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 6-p; and.

WHEREAS, the purpose for this Reserve Fund is to pay for accrued "employee benefits" due an employee on termination of the employee's service.

WHEREAS, "employee benefits" for this purpose shall mean cash payments of the monetary value of accrued and accumulated but unused and unpaid sick leave, personal leave, holiday leave, vacation time, time allowance granted in lieu of overtime compensation and any other forms of payment for accrued but unliquidated time earned by Town employees and payable to Town employees upon termination of service except health insurance, whether by retirement or otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the Reserve Fund is established pursuant to Section 6-p of the General Municipal Law; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to place \$13,062.00 into said Reserve Fund from the DB Fund Town Highway Outside of Village as an initial deposit toward said "employee benefits".

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to section 6-p of the General Municipal Law, as amended, there is hereby established a capital reserve fund to be known as the Vacation and Sick Day Allotment Capital Reserve Fund from DB Fund Town Highway Outside of Village (hereinafter Reserve Fund). The purpose of this Reserve Fund is to pay for accrued "employee benefits" due an employee at the termination of the employee's service; and be it further

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RESOLVED, "employee benefits" shall mean cash payments of the monetary value of accrued and accumulated but unused and unpaid sick leave, personal leave, holiday leave, vacation leave, time allowance granted in lieu of overtime compensation and any other forms of payment for accrued but unliquidated time earned by Town employees and payable to Town employees upon termination of service whether it be by retirement or otherwise; and be it further

RESOLVED, no moneys will be deducted from this Reserve Fund for the payment of health insurance; and be it further

RESOLVED, expenditures may be made from the Reserve Fund for the payment of all or part of the costs including interest of:

(a) cash payment of the monetary value of accumulated or accrued and unused sick leave, holiday leave, vacation leave, time allowance granted in lieu of overtime compensation, and other forms of payment for accrued leave time and benefits due to Town Employees upon termination of Town employment and separation of service as required by ordinance, local law, or collective bargaining.

(b) the reasonable costs of administration of the Reserve Fund; and

(c) Expert or professional services rendered in connection with investigation, adjustment or settlement of claims, actions or judgments relating to claims for accrued employee benefits; and be it further

RESOLVED, if the Town Board determines that the Reserve Fund is no longer needed, any remaining moneys may be transferred to any other Reserve Fund by the General Obligations Law; and be it further

RESOLVED, that \$13,062.00 from the DB Fund Town Highway Outside of Village shall be used to initiate the Reserve Fund toward said "employee benefits"; and be it further

RESOLVED, a referendum is not required either to create or expend moneys from the Reserve Fund; and be it further

RESOLVED, any investments or withdraws in relation to this reserve fund shall be in compliance of section 6-p of the General Municipal Law.

BE IT HEREBY enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Albion as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to establish a reserve fund and will entitle it the Vacation and Sick Day Allotment Reserve Fund from the A Fund Townwide (hereinafter "Reserve Fund"), pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 6-p; and.

WHEREAS, the purpose for this Reserve Fund is to pay for accrued "employee benefits" due an employee on termination of the employee's service.

WHEREAS, "employee benefits" for this purpose shall mean cash payments of the monetary value of accrued and accumulated but unused and unpaid sick leave, personal leave, holiday leave, vacation time, time allowance granted in lieu of overtime compensation and any other forms of payment for accrued but unliquidated time earned by Town employees and payable to Town employees upon termination of service except health insurance, whether by retirement or otherwise; and

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WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to place \$17,932.00 into said Reserve Fund from the Townwide Fund A as an initial deposit toward said "employee benefits".

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to 6-p of the General Municipal Law, as amended, there is hereby established a capital reserve fund to be known as the Vacation and Sick Day Allotment Capital Reserve Fund from Fund A –Townwide (hereinafter Reserve Fund). The purpose of this Reserve Fund is to pay for accrued "employee benefits" due an employee at the termination of the employee's service; and be it further

RESOLVED, "employee benefits" shall mean cash payments of the monetary value of accrued and accumulated but unused and unpaid sick leave, personal leave, holiday leave, vacation leave, time allowance granted in lieu of overtime compensation and any other forms of payment for accrued but unliquidated time earned by Town employees and payable to Town employees upon termination of service whether it be by retirement or otherwise; and be it further

RESOLVED, no moneys will be deducted from this Reserve Fund for the payment of health insurance benefits; and be it further

RESOLVED, expenditures may be made from the Reserve Fund for the payment of all or part of the costs including interest of:

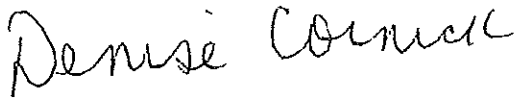
