Dear Dick and Town Board Members,

Bids were received and opened for the above referenced project on Monday March 27, 2023 at the Town of Albion Town Hall. Attached is the Bid Tabulation for the Project.

The lowest bid price received was provided by Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC located in Rochester, New York with a **Total Amount Base Bid of \$219,739.00.** The bid provided by Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC appears to be complete and properly executed. After review of their bid and discussions with Eric Warren, Operating Member/Vice-President from Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC, we offer the following:

- Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC has provided information for our review regarding their company history, references and other information. They have been in business since 2016 under the current name, however, have been around for many decades under a separate company name and structure, has identified thirty-five (35) projects totaling nearly \$19 Million Dollars in value.
- Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC has indicated they are comfortable with their bid and have indicated that they are willing to proceed with the Project. They indicated that the work will be completed within 3-4 weeks (weather permitting). They indicated that they would like to start construction once the Contract Agreement has been executed and indicated they would complete the work before the end of June 2023.
- Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC has indicated that they would be using the Carlisle Roofing material as per the specifications that we have prepared.
- Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC indicated that they would be utilizing Environmental Construction Group (ECG), a local asbestos removal company to provide the material tear off due to the anticipated asbestos material present, and have included the removal and disposal costs accordingly.

- We received bids from six (6) Contractors, with bids ranging from a low bid of \$219,739.00 to a high bid of \$271,256.00. The bids were very competitive, indicating a clear understanding of the project requirements. We feel their bid price is a true representation of costs to complete this work.
- Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC provided an Alternate Bid Price of \$5,800.00 to extend the manufacturers limited warranty from 20-years to 30-years.
- MRB Group has limited prior experience working with Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC and know of no concerns with their company. We have reviewed their project references and they appear to be capable of completing the work planned for this project.

At this time, we see no reason that the Town should deny a contract award for the Project to Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC.

If the Town Board hereby agrees to Award the Albion Town Hall Roof Replacement Project to Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC, and including the Alternate 1 for extension of the warranty, we suggest that you consider the following resolution:

"Award of the Albion Town Hall Roof Replacement to Spring Sheet Metal and Roofing, LLC Base Bid in the amount of \$219,739.00 plus the Alternate Bid for extending the limited warranty from 20 to 30-years in the amount of \$5,800.00, for a Total Amount Bid of \$225,539.00. The Town Board authorizes the Town Supervisor to execute all Contract Documents relating to the Project."

Once a determination has been made by the Town Board regarding Award of the Contract, we will prepare the Notice of Award and forward it to you for your execution.
