TOWN OF ALBION LOCAL LAW #1 OF 2024
AMENDING CHAPTER 99 OF THE
ALBION TOWN CODE

Be it enacted by the Albion Town Board, County of Orleans, State of New York
(hereinafter referred to as the Board), as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE

This Local Law shall be referred to as "Local Law #1 of 2024 Town of Albion,
County of Orleans, Amending Chapter 99 of the Albion Town Code".

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to legislative authority in the Municipal Home Rule
Law and Town Law §261-264.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE AND INTENT

The Town of Albion (sometimes hereinafter referred to as Albion) deems it necessary to
amend this Chapter to update increases in water rates.

SECTION 4: AMENDMENT TO SECTION 99-20A(2)

Albion Town Code §99-20A(2) is hereby deleted as it currently exists and changed to read:

“For water usage above 500 gallons \$4.88 per 1000 gallons. The Town Board may by Resolution in the future change or alter water usage rates set forth in this Section by Resolution rather than Code Amendment.”

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY AND VALIDITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this Local law, or the application thereof to any person, individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this Local Law, or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which said order or judgment shall be rendered.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect upon the date it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law §27.

ALBION TOWN BOARD LOCAL LAW # 2 OF 2024
AMENDING CHAPTER 100 OF THE ALBION TOWN CODE

Be it enacted by the Albion Town Board, County of Orleans, State of New York
(hereinafter referred to as the Board), as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE

This Local law shall be referred to as "Local Law # 2 of 2024 Amending Chapter
100 of the Albion Town Code".

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to the legislative authority in Municipal Home Rule
Law §10 and Town Law §261-264.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE AND INTENT

The Town of Albion (sometimes hereinafter referred to as the Town) deems it necessary
to amend and update the provisions concerning sewage service charges currently set forth in
Albion Town Code §100.

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT TO §100-122

Albion Town Code §100-122 is hereby deleted as it currently exists and changed to read:

“All persons discharging or depositing wastes into the public sewer shall pay a sewer service charge based upon water consumption, which charge shall be collected as a sewer rent, and shall be \$7.04 per one thousand (1,000) gallons. The Town Board may by Resolution in the future change or alter sewer usage rates set forth in this Section by Resolution rather than Code Amendment.”

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY AND/OR VALIDITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this Local Law, or the application thereof to any person, individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect impair or invalidate the remainder thereof but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this Local Law, or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which said order or judgment shall be rendered.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE
